Senior Older Adult Retention (SOAR)	
Elder Financial Exploitation - 2 Lesson Plans	Third Federal offers a fun way for older adults to learn about the financial frauds geared towards their age group. Older adults will play a bingo game and win prizes.
Teach Children to Save (TCTS)	
Grade Levels K-2 - 7 Lessons Plans	Through poetry and stories, the scholars will learn about saving money, characteristics of coins, distinguish between goods and services and offer solutions to money issues.
Grade Levels 3-5 - 4 Lesson Plans	Through stories, scholars learn about what influences the choices consumers make, natural resources used for goods and services, opportunity cost, savings goals, savings plans and saving money despite significant setbacks.
Grade Levels 6-8 - 7 Lesson Plans	Scholars will learn about the value of money, web buying and internet fraud, buying of goods and services, forms of payment, living on a budget, making good purchase decisions and managing credit.
